

**Hike Trails in Aransas County** 




# **Southern Trail** (funded by Aransas Pathways)

- The beginning of the trail is located at the **Connie Hagar Cottage Sanctuary** (corner of Church and First streets).
- The six-foot-wide concrete sidewalk traverses South Rockport, connecting with other hike and bike trails in the City of Rockport.
- This Southern Trail addition provides safe walking from Connie Hagar Cottage Sanctuary to the Aransas Pathways Pavilion 3.35 miles. (The entire route is not shown here. View it at www.AransasPathway.com.)

### Directions for safe bike route

- Begin at the Connie Hagar parking lot trail head (E. 1st and Church St )
- Proceed down 1st St stay on Aransas Pathways Bike
   / Hike Trail
- Take a left on Live Oak and continue on trail
- Cross Market St and continue on Live Oak to Enterprise
- Cross Enterprise go left on sidewalk to Tule Hike and Bike trail to pavilion at end of trail head.
- At trail head turn around and proceed back.
- After crossing Market St proceed to Wharf St and go left
- Cross Main St and proceed to Water St
- Take Water St and take a right on 1st St back to Connie Hagar trail head.

When cycling in Aransas County, as is the case on any public street, always wear a helmet and bright, highly visible clothing. It is also recommended to have a flashing red safety light mounted behind the saddle.

Always ride with the flow of traffic, unless routes converge with sidewalks, and please obey all traffic laws and regulations.
